## Your Funeral Choices

At M. K. Ginder & Sons Funeral Directors we want to ensure that our families can choose the type of funeral they wish to provide for their loved one. It is important to us that they can add family traditions or individual options where they feel necessary and make the funeral truly unique to the person whose life they are celebrating.

We also understand that for some families this may be the first funeral they have had to arrange. We want to help everyone through this process and support them as they pay their final respects.

It is also necessary to ensure that the funeral of choice falls within the budget and allowance the family can afford. It is never our intention to make our customers spend more than they can allow for, therefore we will ensure that we provide you with the costs and charges before any confirmation or decision is made.

To meet all the requirements of the families we serve in our community, we provide three types of funeral service:

- Our Traditional Funeral Service
- Our Simple Funeral Service
- Our Unattended Funeral Service

Details of all three of these options along with prices of additional services we provide are explained within this guide. We have also provided the comparable standardised price lists for the areas we have offices within, should you wish to compare our prices with other providers.

With all funeral arrangements it is important that we first understand what which type of service you would like and therefore a conversation about the choices you have and services you would like to include will be at the forefront of the arrangements.

We want you to feel comfortable with the decisions you make, so please feel free to ask as many questions as you like. We are very happy to answer them.

# Our Traditional Funeral Service

Our Traditional Funeral is the full funeral service option that we have been privileged to provide since 1983. This service allows you to bespoke and tailor all elements of the funeral arrangements to suit the specific wishes of the deceased and family members.

Unlike our Simple and Unattended Funeral Services, there are no restrictions on specific days or times that the funeral can take place, however funerals arranged outside of usual Monday to Friday, 9am to 4pm timings will be subject to additional charges.

## **Our Traditional Funeral Service includes:**

- Our services in arranging all elements of the Funeral. Completion of all the statutory documentation required for the burial or cremation to take place, including liaising with Doctors, Hospitals, HM Coroner, Crematoria and Clergy where necessary.
- Your choice of when the funeral takes place and on what day, subject to availability.
- Provision of a team of professional pall bearers and a dedicated funeral conductor to lead and carry out the funeral.
- The collection of the deceased from a local address, home, hospice, or hospital during normal working hours.
- Care of the deceased prior to the funeral including Embalming and hygienic treatment by a member of the British Institute of Embalmers. Cleansing, preparation and presentation of the deceased.
- Use of our Private Chapel of Rests prior to the funeral.
- The option to hold a funeral service at a Church or place of worship immediately prior to the Crematorium or Cemetery.
- Collection and administration of Charitable Donations, both online and offline.
- Provision of a motor hearse, to your choice of crematoria within a 25- mile journey.

- Assistance with the preparation and purchase of service sheets, funeral flowers, and other funeral additions.

## **Choices available: (as individually costed)**

- Your choice of a wide range of different coffins and caskets from the traditional wooden coffins to fully bespoke designed choices and natural material ranges.
- Provisions of limousines for family and friends attending the funeral.
- Option for Horse-drawn, motorcycle or classic hearses.
- Reception into Church/Coffin taken home prior to the funeral.
- Saturday or Sunday Funerals.

## **Additional Charges will be incurred if:**

- The removal of the deceased is required outside the hours, 8.30am-5pm Monday to Friday. Additional charges also apply for other hospitals and distance removals.
- The removal of a pacemaker or implant device that must be removed prior to cremation.

## **The Traditional Funeral Service does not include:**

- Any fees or disbursements payable on the client's behalf.

## **Our Traditional Funeral Service Charge:**

Fees and Disbursement costs apply to, but are not limited to: Crematoriums, Cemeteries, Place of Worship, Clergy and Officiants, Doctors, Organists, Singers, Service Sheets, Flowers, Catering, Dove Releases, Bagpipers, and other services. Details of these charges are included in our additional price list and from our funeral arrangers.

We kindly ask that all fees and disbursements that we pay on your behalf are paid prior to the funeral and ask that the full funeral account is paid within 30 days of the invoice. We offer a pre-payment discount of **£150.00** for funerals that are paid in **FULL** at least two working days prior to the funeral.

All families that instruct M. K. Ginder & Sons Funeral Directors are entitled to use our bereavement support services. More details are available on our website.

# Our Simple Funeral Service

A simple funeral service allows you the option to organise a traditional funeral service, where certain elements and choices have been reduced to lower the cost. In bygone eras, this had previously been known as a pauper's funeral, and had up until recently been a requisite for membership of our trade associations to provide such a service. It is offered as an option to families who may have a limited budget for funeral expenses, or for an executor or neighbour organising a simple ceremony funeral as part of their duty of care to the person.

Our Simple Funeral Service places certain limitations of dates and times when the funeral can take place. There is also limited offering of the ancillary items that we offer as part of our Traditional Funeral Service. The Simple Funeral allows for a service to take place at the nearest crematorium or cemetery. Family and mourners may attend, and the service can be led by a minister, officiant or member of the family if chosen.

## **Our Simple Funeral Service includes:**

- Our services in arranging the Funeral. Completion of all the statutory documentation required for the burial or cremation to take place, including liaising with Doctors and HM Coroner if necessary.
- Provision of a team of professional pall bearers and funeral conductor to carry out the funeral.
- Provision of a simple coffin (of our choice) suitable for burial or cremation, including a simple ivory, blue or pink gown.
- The collection of the deceased from a local address, home, hospice, or hospital during normal working hours.
- Care of the deceased for up to fourteen days prior to the funeral.
- Provision of a motor hearse, direct to the nearest cemetery or West Herts Crematorium.

## **Additional Charges will be incurred if:**

- The removal of the deceased is required outside the hours, 8.30am-5pm Monday to Friday. Additional charges also apply for other hospitals and distance removals.
- The removal of a pacemaker or implant device that must be removed prior to cremation.
- Viewing the deceased prior to the funeral service.

## **The Simple Funeral Service does not include:**

- Any fees or disbursements payable on the client's behalf.

## **The Simple Funeral Service restrictions are:**

- The Funeral will take place on a Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday.
- The Service at the Crematorium or Cemetery will commence between 9am and 10.30am.

# Our Unattended Funeral Service

## *Alternatively known as A Direct Cremation Service*

An unattended funeral provides the option for you to organise a cremation without a service where we will organise for the coffin to be taken to a local crematorium and return the ashes to office for you to collect. This service is a suitable option for families that live abroad and cannot attend a funeral, or those wishing to hold a memorial service at a later date.

Our Unattended Funeral Service does not have a specific date or time that the cremation takes place. It is not possible for anyone to attend the crematorium; however, a small service may be available if you choose to scatter the ashes in the grounds, which you will arrange directly with the Crematorium.

We recommend that everyone involved is aware that this service provides the minimum requirements for the cremation of the deceased to take place, and everyone should be happy with this decision before proceeding.

### **Our Unattended Funeral Service includes:**

- Completion of all the statutory documentation required for the cremation to take place, including liaising with Doctors and HM Coroner if necessary.
- The collection from a local address, home, hospice, or hospital during normal working hours.
- The care of the deceased prior to the cremation.
- The provision of a coffin suitable for cremation.
- Transfer of the deceased to a local crematorium, with the necessary personnel at a time suitable to us.

### **Additional Charges will be incurred if:**

- The removal of the deceased is required outside the hours, 8.30am-5pm Monday to Friday. Additional charges also apply for other hospitals and distance removals.
- The removal of a pacemaker or implant device that must be removed prior to cremation.
- Viewing the deceased prior to the cremation.

### **The Unattended Funeral Service does not provide any options for:**

- Attending the crematorium at the time of the cremation.
- Having a minister or officiant present at the cremation.
