Unattended Funeral Choices

We offer two types of Unattended funeral, to enable you to choose which option best suits your requirements.

The Heart of England Unattended Funeral is a simplistic direct cremation funeral offering with no service and no mourners attending.

We will bring the deceased into our care from a local place of death (within a 15 mile radius) at any time. Once in our care we will carry out the care and preparation of the deceased, excluding dressing in own clothes but including embalming (subject to permission being granted), we will arrange for viewing in our chapel of rest within office hours, and provide a simple Heritage or York coffin with gown, as per your choice.

The funeral will be arranged to take place at a local crematorium of our choice, at a day and time that is most convenient for us, within 21 days of the completion of all the necessary paperwork.

On the day of the funeral there will be no service and no mourners are able to attend. Our funeral director will be present to ensure that your requests are carried out and we will provide our standard ceremonial motorised hearse with a full complement of pallbearers.

We can also arrange for a free online tribute and donation page as well as obituaries, flowers and memorial stationery at an additional cost should you wish to personalise the funeral.

Where requested cremated remains will be available for collection from the funeral home within 21 days of the cremation taking place.

Our fee includes all Third-Party fees such as Doctor's fees (if applicable) and the crematorium fees, there is no reduction if the Coroner is involved.

The Heart of England Unattended Funeral (including third-party fees) £2,400

The Unattended Funeral is a direct disposition and as such it is not a traditional style funeral, there is no ceremonial service, and no mourners can attend.

We will bring the deceased into our care from a local place of death (within a 15 mile radius) during normal office hours; outside of these hours an additional fee of £260 is payable. Once in our care we will carry out the basic preparation of the deceased, excluding embalming, dressing in own clothes and viewing in our chapel of rest. We will provide a simple coffin.

The direct cremation will be arranged to take place at a designated crematorium of our choosing, at a day and time that is most convenient for us within 21 days of the completion of all the necessary paperwork.

On the day of the cremation we will use our private ambulance with the required number of staff and a wheeled bier to transport the deceased into the crematorium.

Where requested cremated remains will be available for collection from the branch within 21 days of the cremation taking place.

The Unattended Cremation includes all Third-Party fees such as Doctor's fees (if applicable) and the crematorium fees, there is no reduction if the Coroner is involved.

Unattended Funeral (including third-party fees) £1,700

Although these options represent a reduced level of service elements from our more traditional service offering it is important to note that we treat every deceased with the same level of care and respect and their family with the same level of dignity and professionalism as our more traditional funerals.

With both Unattended Funeral options we require payment in full within 5 days of the funeral being arranged, the funeral will not take place until this amount is paid.

Standardised price list

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary).

1. This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.
 2. In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.

Our Charges

Professional services £1,025

Availability of trained and qualified professional personnel 24 hours a day to carry out our clients' requests in line with legal and moral obligations. Handling all of the relevant documentation including liaising with and organising third parties on our clients' behalf. Offering advice, support and guidance on all related matters before, during and after the funeral. This sum covers in excess of 40 work hours on average and appropriate proportion of our overheads.

Terms of Business

For Unattended Funerals we require **payment in full, within 5 working days of the funeral being arranged. The funeral will not take place until this amount is paid in full.** The Unattended funeral is a direct disposition and as such this is not a traditional style funeral service, there is no ceremonial service, and no mourners can attend.

Attended Funerals require a **minimum of a 50% deposit** of the estimated costs **paid within 5 working days of the funeral being arranged. The funeral will not take place until this amount is paid in full.** Our invoice for the outstanding balance will be sent out **2 days** after the funeral service and is due within **30 days** of the invoice date. Failure to pay the outstanding amount due within the specified timeframe will lead to an interest charge of **4%** per month and any associated debt recovery costs being added to the account in line with our Terms & Conditions.

If you live outside of England, payment in full is required before the funeral will take place.
