



# Competition and Markets Authority

The Competition and Markets Authority (CMA) launched a market study into the supply of funerals and related goods and services in June 2018. The CMA wanted to look at concerns around a number of issues, namely that funeral prices were too high, that there were significant price differentials across areas in relation to burial and cremation fees, that there was a lack of transparency around pricing information, that consumers had difficulty in comparing the price of 'funeral packages' and concerns around consumer protection in relation to pre-paid funeral plans.

We, at the Heart of England Co-operative Society, being owned by our members and as a consumer co-operative responded to the CMA's questions stating that we were very transparent with our pricing, in fact we were one of the first funeral directors locally to publish our funeral prices online. We understand that bereavement is a difficult time for most and that we have a responsibility to help our client families charter what may be unfamiliar ground, by giving clear advice based on what the client family require.

In March 2019 the CMA published its report and appointed an inquiry group who were tasked with gathering more information and making recommendations to the market. After numerous further reports and an extension of the timeframe due to Covid-19 the CMA published their final report in December 2020 stating that they would issue a number of 'sunlight' remedies. These were the mandatory introduction of a standardised price list that **all** funeral directors must use, the requirement that crematoriums provide a price list, that funeral directors disclose certain financial information to the CMA, that the solicitation of business is prohibited, and that a registration scheme is put in place as a first step towards broader regulatory regime.

We welcome any steps that make this difficult time easier for our clients and show overleaf the CMA required Standardised Price List. The pages following on show the price for all our services and the products we have traditionally provided to our client families, to better help you make an informed decision about the type of service you may wish to arrange and the associated costs.



## Standardised price list

All funeral directors are legally required to publish this Price List for a standardised set of products and services. This is to help you think through your options and make choices, and to let you compare prices between different funeral directors (because prices can vary).

<sup>1.</sup> This fee (which is sometimes called the interment fee) is the charge made for digging and closing a new grave, or for reopening and closing an existing grave.

<sup>2.</sup> In England, Wales and Northern Ireland, you will usually need to pay doctors' fees as well. This is the charge for two doctors to sign the Medical Certificates for Cremation.

## **Terms of Business**

For Unattended funerals we require payment in full, within 5 working days of the funeral being arranged. The funeral will not take place until this amount is paid in full. The Unattended funeral is a direct disposition and as such this is not a traditional style funeral service, there is no ceremonial service, and no mourners can attend. The funeral will be arranged at a local cemetery or crematorium of our choosing at a day and time that is most convenient to us within 14 days of completion of all the necessary paperwork. For cremations the cremated remains will be available from the funeral home within 21 days of the service.

Attended Funerals require a minimum of a 50% deposit of the estimated costs paid within 5 working days of the funeral being arranged. The funeral will not take place until this amount is paid in full. Our invoice for the outstanding balance will be sent out 2 days after the funeral service and is due within 30 days of the invoice date. Failure to pay the outstanding amount due within the specified timeframe will lead to an interest charge of 4% per month and any associated debt recovery costs being added to the account in line with our Terms & Conditions.
